Invitation to Submit Manuscripts: You are cordially invited to submit a paper for review and possible publication in the *Portuguese Studies Review* 22.2 (2014). The papers should be 6,000-12,000 words long, inclusive of footnotes. Their acceptance is contingent on the results of a double-blind peer review.

Language and Style: The papers may be in Portuguese, English, French, or Spanish. Papers in English need to follow the PSR house style. Papers in Portuguese, French, and Spanish may follow other styles, but all papers are required to use footnotes.

Submission Deadline and Peer Review Process: The finalized manuscripts should be submitted by **August 30 2014** to Dr. Ivana Elbl (ielbl@trentu.ca). If you prefer to submit ahead of the deadline, the review process will begin upon the receipt of the submission. All manuscripts should be sent, in email attachment (supported formats are .odt, .doc., .docx).

The editors will then initiate the peer review process. The review process will be handled as follows: Literature and Language -- Dr. Maria João Dodman; History and Non-Literary Humanities – Dr. Ivana Elbl; Social Sciences and Applied Social Sciences (Drs. Fernando Nunes and Robert Kenedy).

Notification of Acceptance: early to mid-October 2014. Revised papers will be due within **two weeks** of the notification of acceptance, by email attachment to Dr. Ivana Elbl (ielbl@trentu.ca) unless agreed otherwise.

Typographical Proofs will be sent out, digitally in email attachment, in early December 2014.

Release Date: End of December 2014.
